Our Report: The month of June began with our travels to the state of Indiana. God blessed us with the opportunity to present our burden in two churches and edify the saints. We travelled on to North Carolina for a Missions conference and participated in "Operation Saturation" on Saturday the 12th. What a blessing it was to get out into communities inviting folks to church and sharing the gospel with those that allowed us to speak with them. We exhorted several with the truth that "...God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us." (Rom. 5:8). The Gospel of Christ is what men need to hear, and must hear if they would be saved. We continued our travels throughout North Carolina and then on to Georgia sharing our burden and preaching God's Word! We were privileged to attend a tent meeting in Spring City, TN at the end of June and witnessed God save a lost soul. One brother had a burden, his church had a vision, and a preacher had a tent—and it gave another sinner opportunity to be saved. The following night after the tent meeting, Benjamin woke up in the middle of the night with severe symptoms such as chest tightness, nearly blacking out, and numbness and tingling throughout the extremities of the body. We only give the details as we do desire your prayers. After two nights in the hospital, and extensive testing, no real answers have been found. We are taking a week off from travelling to allow for rest and recuperation; however, the neurological symptoms continue as this letter is being written. Would you help us pray for God's grace and guidance.

- that there would be a genuine revival of New Testament Christianity among the Lord's people.

Our Rejoicing: Just as we did in May, we have had 5 more churches in June choose to partner with us in reaching Oregon and the Northwest USA which brings us to 59.9% of our support. We do rejoice in how God's people sacrifice in order to send others forward with the Gospel. We must see our great land, whose greatness is swiftly fading, reached with the Gospel! We rejoice in the doors set before us to share the gospel and invite sinners to bow before the Savior, even the Lord Jesus Christ.

We rejoice that even though we are compassed about with perplexities, and clothed with our many infirmities, we can trust God and His grace. We do rejoice in the sufficient grace of God and the sufficient power of Christ, and earnestly desire for both to rest upon our lives. We must therefore glory in our infirmities and say that our stay in the hospital allowed us to confront many with the Person of Jesus Christ and His strength to save their soul from sin and hell.

We can never say it enough—**Thank You** to every church and every Christian that is standing with us in these days as we seek to further the Gospel and forward the faith of Christ. May God and His grace be with you all.
