Showing the generation to come:

I don't think it comes as a surprise to anyone that the ministry of my heart is children, and how blessed I am that God has made the heart of my ministry to be teaching His Word to them. Each Sunday morning I get to walk into a classroom full of 4-7 year old little girls and share with them what I learned from my Sunday school teachers when I was their age.



The beginning of July began my rotation of teaching our Little Soldiers class on Wednesday night. The age range there is 4-11 years. That can be a daunting task to keep the lessons on the level a 4 year old can understand and not bore the older ones. But the Bible is so different from any other book. It isn't my teaching that the children will carry with them, but how God spoke to them upon hearing His Word. I love the passage from the Psalms that I started out with above. My hope and my prayer is that the children the Lord has given me to minister to will learn to set their hope in Him, and not in the things the world has to offer them.

We have also been able to restart our Bible Clubs. This is a tremendous step out of the changes the pandemic caused. The first Saturday of each month, we go out into different communities and gather the children into an empty field or schoolyard and have a time of games, songs, snacks, and a Bible story. We are so blessed to have enough workers that we can go to 2 different communities each time and share the love of God with double the children that we could before the quarantine began. We have seen many children start riding the bus to church because of these outreaches. These children not only come and learn for themselves, but also begin to bring their friends with them. What a privilege it is to have a small part in all of this, and what a great responsibility to teach the generation to come.
