
Dear Friends,

We are back! The paperwork, the anticipation, and the 44-hour journey are all behind us. We are back in Papua New Guinea! The Lord has blessed us greatly, and we are so thankful He has provided the means to get us back to this land! Thank you all for praying!


Our trip from Atlanta to Port Moresby was a long one. On May 18, we flew from Atlanta to New York City. We then embarked on a twelve-hour flight to Doha, Qatar. The airport was beautiful, and we all got much-needed showers. After five hours in Doha, we flew eight hours to Singapore. We, along with several other transiting passengers, were confined to one small area within one of the terminals. We spent six hours there before we were escorted (in a single-file line that Cassia had a hard time maintaining) to our plane heading to Port Moresby. After a six-hour flight, we arrived May 21 at 5:10 am in Port Moresby, Papua New Guinea! We were exhausted. We took a bus to our designated quarantine hotel, and as we rode, all I could do was weep. After so much effort we were finally back in the place of our calling!

We are now in the process of moving to Alotau. It is the provincial capital for the Milne Bay province. This province is an archipelago of islands scattered off the southeastern tip of Papua New Guinea. The Lord has directed us to minister to these islands with the goal of establishing churches on many of them. There is a Bible-believing church here in Alotau, and we are working alongside this church to further the gospel to this massive province. The first island we visited was Kiriwina Island. This place is steeped in false religion and witchcraft. I was able to preach the gospel there and had many attend the service, including a member of Parliament. We are now working on obtaining a piece of land there so we can start a church. Please pray that we can successfully secure this land, and please pray for the people there to be receptive to the true Gospel!
