Dear Friends,

As God's children, we have a rich inheritance. It is not simply money, or land, or a title, but our inheritance is God himself, and with God we get access to everything He possesses. Not only does God provide His children with His richness, He is the one who maintains it all. He keeps the grass cut, pays the bills, and prevents evil from robbing us of our eternal blessings!

Praise the Lord we are finally finished settling into our home. It took several flights back and forth to Port Moresby, a 20ft container, and six-hour bus ride to complete it all, but we are finished! We have traveled to Kerema, Port Moresby, Alotau, and some surrounding areas all in the past two weeks gathering cargo to move to Alotau. At each stop the Lord opened doors for me to preach in churches and challenge Papua New Guineans to be concerned about the Great Commission themselves. I confess everywhere that if God can use Caleb Wilson, then He can certainly use anyone.

As mentioned before, our focus is to minister to the Trobriand Islands (a 45 minute flight north of Alotau.) We were planning weekly trips up to this island to preach and scout land for starting a church; however, they have recently closed the airstrip on this island indefinitely for maintenance issues. A boat trip to this island is two days journey, which I can make, but the family would not be able to go with me (weather, pirates, sicknesses.) Also, taking the boat would mean my trips up there would be much less frequent, considering how long it takes to get there and back. I ask you to please pray they open the airstrip soon so we can continue to be a light to those people, and pray as well, that if God is indeed closing the door to this place, that He will direct us to exactly where He wants us to go next.

The family is well. There has been some sickness, but it is all due to us continuing to acclimate to a new part of the country. Tabitha started a weekly ladies class at a church here in Alotau. She has more experience in PNG than most people, and the Lord has opened a door for her to effectively minister to these dear ladies.

We appreciate your continued prayers and support. Please remember these prayer requests that have been mentioned. Pray for the islands to be reached, pray for the people to respond positively, and pray for the Lord to send more laborers to reap the harvest! God always provides!
