It has been raining a bit more as Valledupar is entering the rainy season. We have been on the road in the last few weeks and are trying to get a lot of things done in a short time. I had the opportunity to preach two services in Tunja. I trust that it was a blessing to them. Martha also was able to teach the ladies. Hannah had to undergo an oral surgery to take out her wisdom teeth and ran into a bit of a problem due the complexity. Thank the Lord, she was well enough in time to fly to Atlanta.

Things Away From Valledupar

As a requirement for travel to the U.S., we took a COVID test and filled out several forms and apps that the government requires for international travel. We had the blessing of spending a few days with my mom in Tennessee, who Martha and Hannah have not seen since 2017. It was great to see her again. Even though, we witnessed a scary situation when my mom fell backwards as she was entering the house and hit the back side of her head and greatly bruised her right arm. The ambulance came to help her and carry her to stabilize her. Thank the Lord, she did not break a bone, although it will take several weeks to recuperate. Things get a bit complicated because she takes blood thinners. She turns 87 this year and lives alone. I am thankful for the neighbors who look out for her.

Hannah Going To College

About a week later, we arrived in Pensacola to help Hannah make the transition of living on campus. We have been blessed by a Church where we stayed in the Atlanta area and a Church here that has allowed us to stay close to the University for a few days to help Hannah through this new experience in her life. I was asked at the Church where we have been staying, to speak to the bus kids on Sunday morning. It was a great joy to see nine of that group either accept the Lord or receive assurance of their salvation.

Things Taking Place In Valledupar

Brother Simeon has been in charge while we have been away. Brother Wilesme also has been helping him to observe the protocols that the government requires. The many restrictions off and on have really affected things with the Church. We wonder when things will start to get back to normal. We continue to do what the Lord called us to do in sharing His Word with others.

We are still planning for the missionary to be with us in October.
