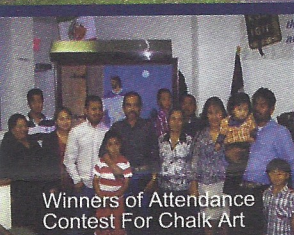

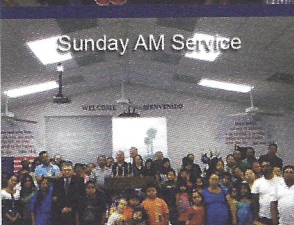

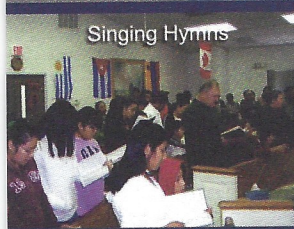

Prayer Letter July and August 2021

September 10, 2021

Dear Prayer Partners,

I am writing this for my husband, Ben Millican, who passed away on July 20, 2021. It was hard for me and my family and our church, Iglesia Bautista Nuevo Testamento. As you all know Ben had been having a hard time breathing and had been to the doctor who sent him for x-rays, chest cat scan and a PET scan. The PET scan showed that he had nodules and a possible tumor on his lungs. On July 20th, we went to the pulmonologist to find out what he recommended to Ben. He gave him a steroid shot, nose spray and different allergy pills. The doctor sent us for other lab work and a 6 minute walk without oxygen, looking for possible asthma. That day Ben said he could not do that anymore. That night he said he was so tired and he just wanted to go to bed. He first needed to use the restroom so I helped him because he was shaking. I called our Pastor friend and his wife and told them what was going on with Ben and that he didn't want me to call the ambulance or the para medics.. I brought him to bed, massaged his chest and blew into his mouth but the air just went out of his mouth, and I was unable to hear a heartbeat. The para medics came and tried to revive him but were unsuccessful. They asked about his medical conditions. I told them that he had 3 heart attacks, diabetes and they checked his meds. After answering their questions, they finally told me not to have an autopsy. Ben had requested his funeral to be in Alabama, where he was to be buried.

It is sad for me, leaving my church and friends here in LaBelle, Florida. Please pray for me. Right now, I am packing and moving to Alabama to live close to family.

Thank you all for your prayers, kind words, sympathy and gifts for helping in this trying time.

I am very grateful for all of your kindness.
