Dear Pastors, Churches, and Friends,

We are troubled on every side, yet not distressed; we are perplexed, but not in despair; Persecuted, but not forsaken; cast down, but not destroyed; - II Corinthians 4:8-9

We've read these verses many times, but over the past several months, we've lived them. It seems the closer we get to Wales, the harder the enemy fights to knock us down. We have already scheduled our exit interview with our mission board, and our travel agent (who also happens to be my mom) is working hard to find us the best flight. The Downeys are looking for a house and vehicle for us. This week, we even purchased an electric piano in Wales for Dana. The Downeys picked it up for us and are keeping it safe until we arrive and have a place to put it. As you can probably tell, we're getting very excited about moving into our new calling.

We still have much to do before we're ready to go, but we trust God will continue leading and guiding us every step of the way. Some of you have already sent in offerings to help us with our many upcoming expenses, and for that, we are truly grateful. God has allowed us to save up a nice sum, but every little bit helps when moving to a new country and starting again from scratch.
