Dear Fellow Laborer's in Christ,

Donna and I are always grateful to you all for your faithful prayers and financial support. And we count it an honor to be your co-laborers for the cause of Christ in Brazil. We pray and trust you all are faring well too. Though our circumstances may vary, we all are experiencing the same world crisis in one way or another.

Before our tires are even cooled off from a trip lately, they are turning again. As the Lord is graciously giving us many opportunities to report and present the work in Brazil. Some were a complete surprise! One Sunday morning, we visited a church in Pinnacle, NC. The Pastor invited us back that evening and asked me to preach. A few weeks later, we were in LaGrange, GA, where we headed to a church one Sunday evening and discovered that they weren't having Sunday evening services. So we switched to "plan B." And, with one minute left 'till starting time! The Pastor at the next church was stepping up to the pulpit as we walked in that evening. And, seeing us come in, he came down from the pulpit to greet us. And after we introduced ourselves, to my utter surprise, he asked if I was ready to preach. And upon finishing the congregational singing, I was at the pulpit directing the congregation to the passage of Scripture from where I preached. We had never been to this church before, and after the service, the Pastor invited us to come back, and he scheduled me to preach again later.

We recently attended our Mission Board's Annual Conference, held in Greenville, SC, this year. There were thirty-one missionary families present during this meeting with whom we thoroughly enjoyed wonderful fellowship each day. And God greatly encouraged us from His word through Holy Spirit-filled preaching throughout the conference! And we praise Him for tending to and meeting our needs, amen! Personally, Donna and I went to this conference needing and petitioning God for encouragement.

Please pray for the Lord's hedge of protection around us as we travel. The amount of traffic on the roads lately has truly baffled us! We acknowledge that "safety is of the Lord" (Pr. 21:31b). Would you also pray with us about a couple of needs? The Lord has provided for us to live/travel in a camper during this furlough. Donna needs one of those compact, one-unit-washer/dryer machines (not enough space for two units). And we're finding ourselves many times needing a portable 50 amp inverter/generator. We greatly appreciate everyone praying with us for these needs.
