### Prayer Letter – November 2021

Dear Praying Friends,

**A TREMENDOUS OPPORTUNITY** - Thank you for praying for my recent trip to Quito, Ecuador. Quito is the capital city of Ecuador and is situated high up in the Andes Mountains. It has an altitude of 9,350 feet above sea level. It is a city of 2 million people, but if you add the adjoining cities the population rises to over 7 million. This represents a tremendous opportunity for missionaries. Pray that the Lord of the harvest would send laborers into this ripened field.

**A TREMENDOUS EFFORT** - Camilo, his wife Mariela, and his two daughters; Macarena and Eden have been in Quito since June of 2021. They have been working hard to get everything in order to plant a church in the Calderón community, and they have made tremendous progress in a short period of time. A couple of months ago they inaugurated the Way Baptist Church. Last month a seminary student named Bastian, from Iquique, Chile, went to help Camilo. Since his arrival they have passed out 10,000 invitations, and their effort is paying off. Camilo, Bastian and Mariela conduct Bible studies throughout the week and on the Sunday that I was with them they had their first baptism.

**A TREMENDOUS NEED** - Please join us in praying for one of the new converts to be able, and willing, to fill the void that will be felt by Camilo, when Bastian returns to his seminary studies in Chile. Camilo will definitely need someone to accompany him as he evangelizes and disciples new converts.

**MISSION CONFERENCE – Urucará, Brazil** -The Lord willing, this January, I will be going to Urucará, Brazil which is located on the Uatumã River. I will be preaching a Mission Conference, and we will also be holding services at a new work at Paraná do Comprido.
