Ministry

Praise the Lord for another exciting month in His service. We have chosen to send a letter just for October because we wanted to share some things God is doing here. First of all, we had yet another baptism, where we baptized two young women from the church. The first was a young lady from here, that started attending the church after we moved to our new building. The second was my sister in law from Romania, who was saved here a few years ago. We had the privilege of having Bro. Jim Morgan, the missionary to Romania; that led my wife to Christ, with us. We had Bro. Morgan to be involved with the baptisms, to honor him, as he retires from the mission field to take on a new ministry out of his home church. Bro. Morgan was here for the wedding of my wife's oldest sister.

Which brings us to the next great event, our first wedding to be held in the church. My wife's sister Georgiana, and Jonas, one of the men in our church, were married at the end of October. Jonas was the first person to ask to follow the Lord in baptism, in our church; and my long time soul winning partner. It was so exciting to be a part of this, and see the love of our church as they worked so hard to make it a blessed day for them. Equally exciting, was to have the opportunity to preach the Gospel to a great number of lost people, who attended the wedding. We actually saw our church filled almost to its maximum capacity. I also want to mention that in the last letter, I said we would likely need to increase our seating in the church; we have now had to do just that. Since that letter we have seen the church grow even more, and have add in extra rows of seating to accommodate it. For the wedding we were actually able to increase seating all the way up to eighty chairs, meaning if necessary this building can accommodate all the chairs we currently own. That is exciting news for the future of the church, and our desire to buy a building.

At the beginning of the month we celebrated International Day. For this we had a meal with foods from the countries represented in the church, and people to dress in clothes traditional to their country. We also had an international choir, where we sung "I Need Thee Every Hour" in ten different languages.

Every year in October we also take on a missions/evangelism project, this year our project was to raise money, to send Bibles and tracts to the Philippines. Since we have people in our church from there, we have a way to send them inexpensively. Currently we have raised an estimated 600.00 euros for this mission's project. We will be sending these in late November; as well as toys, for the children there, to fill space in the boxes. Please pray that God will bless this project, and the churches that receive them.

Pray for us to be able to continue to expand our ministry, and for God to bless our current work for Him.

Pray for a missionary friend, who due to covid restrictions will likely have to leave his mission field soon.
