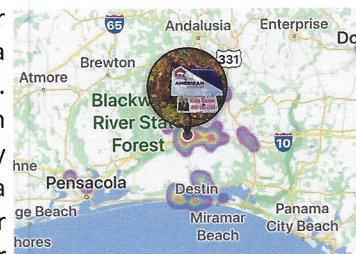
Dear Faithful Co-laborers,

Medical Update: We appreciate all the prayers during Cathy's surgery and our bouts with covid. I was able to return to church the second Sunday in September, in part because we were comfortable leaving Cathy. She was able to return to church services after 2 months and has gradually gotten back into a routine. Her recent doctor's appointment revealed that she still has some pneumonia, and her normal stamina will take some time to return. I still do not have normal taste and smell, but we are grateful for God's blessings. We have scheduled cataract surgery for November 16th. Due to the delicate nature of the corneal transplants, we felt it best to be in Atlanta under the care of the eye group that did our other surgeries. Please pray that all will go well as there is some risk to the grafts. On October 22nd we were able to meet in Georgia with Cathy's sister and brother-in-law where we celebrated mom Ruby's 89th birthday with family and friends before bringing her back to Florida. She had been in SC over 3 months but after only a week at home, she fell and broke her hip which resulted in surgery the next morning. It has been very difficult on her not always understanding clearly what is taking place. Please pray for her as she will be in a rehab facility for therapy a few weeks.

We want to take this opportunity to wish all of you a very blessed and **Happy Thanksgiving** with your loved ones wherever you may be. We are grateful to all of you, whether you send financial support, prayer support or both, we could not serve here without this very important combination. We pray for you often and trust that God will bless your lives as you minister where He places you.
