Ministry in Viñani

We continue to visit in this area weekly, and have been able to share the Gospel with many of the parents of the kids and teenagers that we have contact with.

Please continue to pray for us as we seek a place to buy or rent for the church plant in Viñani. We have found a piece of property that we are interested in purchasing, and ask that you would pray for wisdom and provision concerning this opportunity.

Christian School

For a number of years it has been the burden of our church to begin a Christian school. Different times, we thought it was time, and it seemed like God said, "Wait." Now, we are so excited that God has provided, and our coworker, Bethany Homan, is in the process of purchasing a piece of land for the future school. Again, much prayer and provision will be needed, but we are thrilled to see how God has led and provided to take this huge step.

We are excited about holding a missions conference at church in the month of November. This will be the first in-person special meeting since before the quarantines began. Also, we are in the midst of preparations for several Christmas outreaches and activities. Please pray for God to work in hearts and that others might be saved and believers encouraged through these opportunities.
