Greetings in the name of the Lord.

I want to thank all of you for your faithful prayers and giving in this uncertain time. We thank God for your sacrifice.

Deborah and the boys are doing well. Joseph is growing tall. Joshua just had his 12<sup>th</sup> birthday. Deborah and the boys are hitting school hard. They push each other to double up some days so they can have a day here and there off from school. We were able to take a short two-day vacation and go down to the ocean. It was good to get away, and the boys enjoyed us all being together and relaxing away from town. Deborah is teaching some girls how to read and she enjoys that. She has also made friends with some of our neighbors and visits them often.

Our church hasn't recovered fully after covid shut us down for several months. Our teens, many of whom hit junior high and high school, have been influenced by their friends. The Devil has fought hard to discourage and disrupt the ministry here in many ways. We still have some faithful, but many are occasional now instead of devout. Pray for a boy named Emmanuel. I believe he is going in the wrong direction.

Pray for our land situation. We bought land for the church, but it is stuck in court. Corruption here is unreal and it is hard to know what is real. Money might not be able to buy happiness but it can buy anything else here. We are wanting to move when we can. The building we have been renting for almost 4 years is a store front. This storefront has a second story which the landlord rented the space above us to a charismatic church that sings for two hours/yells in tongues, but doesn't preach much. Last Wednesday night was their first night. It was awful trying to yell loud enough so our people could hear. Every time God does something the Devil tries to shut it down.

Pray for the radio broadcasts. We are currently on the air 6 times a week, Monday through Friday morning at 5:30am on one station and 9:00pm on another. It is impossible to know what the impact of this is, but pray that God would use it greatly. I am witnessing to one of the DJ's and the witness was a little heated last week. I think he is starting to see the truth, but he is controlled by the music which is also his profession. Pray for DJ Cash, that is his nickname.

Pray for our Saturday visitation. We are in a neighboring village witnessing right now. We have gone through our village about 3 times or more since I have been here. We have started in surrounding villages. People don't go far for church usually, but they need the gospel. Pray for James our electrician I have been witnessing to. Pray that God would help us to reach these Ghanaians with the gospel. Most are very religious, but don't understand the gospel because they have never heard it. We have churches on every corner almost but very little gospel being preached. It is very sad.
