Little Fish Ministries Update:

- During a court session for two of our little fish, Nathaniel was able to give the gospel to an intern from another non-profit organization. This young lady had never heard about how Jesus gave His life for our sins. She came to church the following Sunday where she received Christ as her Savior!
- A new little fish was added to the Little Fish family. "A" is a precious young girl that has experienced extreme trauma already in her young life. She has been welcomed and loved since her arrival at the LFM property. Pray for her transition into a new environment and family.
- A second water borehole (well) is being dug on the LFM property. The first borehole caved-in, but was also high in salt content, making it almost undrinkable. Due to the unstable water supply in Port Elizabeth, a fresh water supply on the property would be a huge answer to prayer. Pray the new well will be stable and low salt levels.
- We have had yet another baptismal service! God continues to grow His church through three new converts obeying the Lord in believers' baptism.
- Abundant Life Baptist Church celebrated its two-year anniversary this month. God has been good to Abundant Life as it continues to grow numerically and spiritually.
- Another week brings yet another opportunity to give the gospel in a local teen boy home. The administration contacted us several weeks ago about coming weekly to share about our Jesus. These young men desperately need mentorship, but ultimately need to know about the God Who created them, loves them, and wants to save them.
- One building has been completed on the LFM property. A former horse stable has been converted into duplex style cottages for teammates Hannah (staff nurse) and Lorna (house mama). We are so happy to have them on the property now!
- Due to the number of buildings on the property and the ones to come soon, the electrical grid will need a major boost. For the LFM expansion to continue, a new transformer must be installed on the property. The cost for this transformer and installation is about \$12,000 (USD). This will need to be purchased and installed before any more buildings can be utilized. We have roughly four weeks to raise the funds for this urgent need.
