We praise the Lord Jesus Christ for giving us a new year to serve Him together here in the 20th largest country in the world, the country of Thailand. We thank each of you so much for your continuous support and prayers which has allowed us to renew our visas for another year, allowed us to restart our Thursday night Bible study and prayer meeting in the Pa Mai Deng community and allowed us to move the Sunday evening services of Wiang Ping BC to the Pa Mai Deng community which has allowed us to see several new people start coming often to the Thursday night and Sunday evening services and has allowed us to see our girls and our only girl student of Ban Samuel leadership and Bible training center start outreach Bible classes to the children in this community and has allowed us to see two people here in Wiang Ping BC decide to follow the Lord in baptism. We also like to thank you all for the birthday and Christmas greetings and for the sacrificial Christmas offerings.

In October, Naabo suddenly went to be with our Lord. She was the first person of Wiang Ping BC to go be with our Lord, since we have been here in Thailand. We praise the Lord that she left a good testimony of being faithful to the Lord and in trying to encourage others to come to know and follow the Lord. And we praise the Lord that her four adult children are coming regularly to the church services and are coming closer together. We are praying that they will allow the Lord through His Word to lead their daily lives and help them get the victory over several battles in their lives. We also thank the Lord that through your faithful support, over a year ago we were able to help Wiang Ping BC purchase a plot of land that came available in a cemetery for the burial of any members that go be with the Lord before He comes back. Being able to buy this plot of land was a big burden off the shoulders of Wiang Ping BC because there are few cemeteries here because the majority of Thais are cremated and most of the cemeteries are private cemeteries in which you have to be a member of a social or religious group to be buried in them.

We thank the Lord that from around the mid of Octo-

ber the daily covid cases started falling and we saw the Lord answer one of our prayers of being able to go to the home community of one of the faithful attenders of Wiang Ping BC and have a Christmas outreach to get to know people and let them know who we are and letting them know that soon we will be starting a Bible study there. Through all of us working together there were 3 family members that made professions of faith in this community.

Since our last prayer letter things were starting to get better but unfortunately Omicron arrived and stopped us from having the additional outreaches that we were planning to do for Christmas. But we do praise the Lord that the attendance of the churches are starting to increase and that no one in the churches has had a severe case of covid. We are also trying to challenge the brethren here to love the Lord more than they ever have and allow Him to use their life more than ever because we do not know how much longer we have in this world. Please pray with us that the brethren here will do this for the glory of the Lord and will get involved more in the ministries of the churches here.

Please continue to pray for the Pa Mai Deng community outreach as the man that raised money years ago from different places to build a church building there has allowed us to start using the building for now.

I would like to ask if anyone has any musical instruments or microphones lying around that you would like to donate to please email me because we will put them to use as we are trying to help enlarge the music in the churches here. 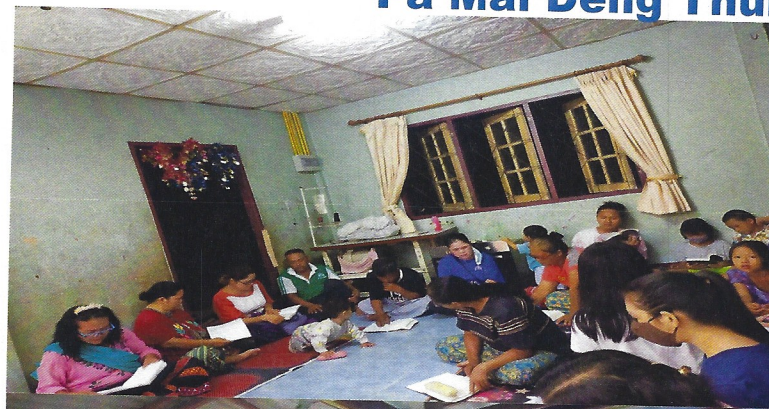
