We are thankful for all that God has done and His blessings upon us. God's grace is always sufficient and He is always right. The longer we serve Him the more we realize that His timing is always perfect. His ways are always true. His plan is always wise. Since coming to New Mexico we have discerned the great need for churches to be established in this area of the country. We have seen Harvest Baptist Church established in Santa Fe, as well as Inglesia Baptista Le Cosecha (Harvest Baptist Church in Spanish) started as a mission of this church in Casas Grandest, Chihuahua, Mexico. The need is still great. I can take you to a dozen towns within a 3-hour driving distance where I am at right now that need churches. Because of this need the Lord has laid it on my heart to start an independent Baptist fellowship of pastors that will work cohesively with each other in the establishment of churches here in the southwest. Our goal is to see new church planters helped as they come to this area both financially and physically. Churches that are already here, when God lays it on their heart to start churches in their area, will help one another in the establishment of these new church plants. We will be having our first meeting of the Southwest Baptist Fellowship of Evangelism one week from today at the Harvest Baptist Church. Pray that through these quarterly meetings that relationships will be established that will further the gospel message as well as the establishment of new churches in our area over the next several years and decades.

We have seen a number of people saved and baptized through the last several months. One in particular rises to my mind. Danny King came into our church several months ago weeping. Danny has Parkinson's disease. His dad had passed away a week or so before. His wife who had had cancer had chosen our state's newly approved assisted suicide medication. She was the first individual to take advantage of this horrendous new law that was passed in our state. This is where doctors can help and assist in people who choose not to live. Danny was broken, and as he came into my office, he spoke with me for a few minutes. I encouraged him to stay for the church service. During the service, one of our men took him aside and dealt with him privately where Danny received Jesus as his Saviour. Since then Danny has been baptized and hardly will ever miss a church service. It is wonderful to see what God can do through His salvation in an individual's life.

Pray for Courtney; we will be scheduling a C-section delivery for the new baby to be born in less than six weeks. Pray that all goes well and God keeps both mother and baby safe. Continue to pray for the church and the mission works that minister out of it, as people continue to get saved and become more established. Pray for Wilderness Baptist Camp as it looks like we will be having another strong camp this year. God is good all the time and we praise the Lord for His blessings.
