

Among those who are new to the church, are a brother and sister that live in Correggio. That is the same area that God has put on our hearts to plant a church in after Foggia. They are very excited about following Christ, and have already said that they are willing to help with this effort! God is at work! On March 7th, other preachers from across Italy will gather here in Reggio Emilia and we will ordain Fausto as a pastor. Then, Lord willing, at the end of March, we will have the honor and privilege to send out Fausto and Maria Pia as Independent Baptist church planters to start the Light Baptist Church in Foggia, Italy. They are currently in the second half of their internship here, and they have truly been a blessing! What a precious couple they are with a heart for God.

We are also grateful to the Lord for His protection on our family as Kristan and Titus just had covid over the last two weeks. Kristan only had a mild time of 3-4 days of sickness with only lingering exhaustion as a result. Titus barely had symptoms, which is a huge answer to prayer, as he is asthmatic. During this time, Tullio was sick and ended up at the emergency room only to be told he also has covid. He was very close to death, so we asked him to come and stay with us since we also were in quarantine with covid. He had 5 very rough days with falling, passing out before he had to be hospitalized last Saturday. Praise the Lord. he is doing much better now.

Friends, we would like to give an open invitation to anyone that has a burden for the souls of Italy. We are in need of helpers here in Reggio Emilia: be it preachers, youth workers, secretaries, teachers, etc. We are thanking God for the wonderful blessing of so many ministry opportunities and people to be discipled, that our family and those we are training here cannot do it all.
