We have been able this month to visit with some of our supporting churches, giving an update and ministering in the Word as we traveled to be in several new churches to present our burden and preach the Word. The Lord is always so gracious to us and the churches of God are a blessing in our lives and ministry. Thank you to all who support us and pray for us. We love you all.

We had the opportunity to reach out again to Tommy in our home town area. He was hesitant to talk with us about the Lord and we would ask you to continue praying for him. He has many questions concerning our Lord Jesus Christ. He was raised, and still remains in the spiritual darkness which Catholicism produces among its followers. He needs to be regenerated by the power of the Holy Spirit. Please pray for his conversion.

We found ourselves on top of Mont Eagle Mtn in TN the first Sunday and Monday of the year with 5 inches of snow. Then here at the last of January (29-31), we were more or less following the storm which dumped lots of snow on the Northeast, New Jersey, Delaware, and Maryland. Some places had nearly 2 foot of snow, while the most we saw was 10 inches. As we came into DE, the roads were not completely cleared yet, and we soon were driving on white, snow covered roads. I allowed the 4 wheel drives to fly past us on the left, and stayed behind a Tractor-Trailer. He plowed through 3-4 inches of snow and I followed in his tracks. After 10 miles or so, we found better roads and made it safely in. Thank the Lord for having what we needed at just the right time. The churches remained open on Sunday, and we enjoyed visiting with God's saints in DE and MD and sharing our burden for the Lord's work and sharing God's Word as well.
