Now to Iquique, Brother Marcelo is like Luke to me. He has been by my side to help me when many became a Demas. I want to return there to ordain him as he has been doing the ministry all this time. The coronavirus has hit Chile hard with all the lockdowns. Please pray for me as I plan this trip.

Please pray for Brother Marcelo and his wife Carla as they deal with a family issue that has broken and burdened their hearts greatly.

I want to thank you for your Christmas gifts. They have helped to pay hospital and doctor bills.
