Greetings,

January 2022

I wanted to thank you all for your prayers and support. This year I will have been with Macedonia for 20 years. Seems like a long time but time speeds up the older I get.

Deborah and the boys are doing fine they are working on another school year. Joshua is not a big fan of school, but Deborah assures him that he will finish school one way or the other ha ha. Joseph is taller than I am now; I told him that was no big deal most are. Jeremiah is starting to grow and is doing well in school.

We are going to take a 10-month furlough starting in mid-March. Jeremy Kenney has agreed to watch the work while we go home so that when I come back he will go off to start a work in a very needy place. We will be in the US from March to January 2023. I have some things I need to take care of as soon as I get to the states so we won't be on the road until May. If you want us to come by your church, please send me a message on Facebook. The second is the one I have had for about 23 years. You can text message me at 011556142643, and I will call you back. If you have a mission conference or a date you want me in, please let me know. I know I have something booked for the last full week in August but nothing else at this moment. I will be taking some time here and there with Deborah and the boys so that we can have some down time together. It is rare that we have a day off on the field, and I plan on taking some off in the US.

We have been very busy in the ministry. Deborah has started a small Bible club with our neighbors. She is also working on helping some of them read.

Last year I was preaching 9 times a week. I have now dropped 4 days on the radio. I am now preaching on the radio 2 days a week and 3 times at the church.

After going door to door through our village about 4 times, we have started to go to a neighboring village on Saturday mornings evangelizing.

Our people here are very religious, and it is easy to get them to repeat a prayer or say whatever. Most Ghanaians are charismatic, but almost none of them know the gospel. I have been witnessing to preachers, and they have no idea what the gospel is but probably 80% of the people in our area identify as Christian. It is very difficult in our area when you know the confusion and you know it takes time before our people understand the gospel and are ready to be saved.

Pray for our church land as we are still waiting for the paperwork to get out of the court system. It is frustrating to wait for things to get through a corrupt system. Pray also for our church people. Almost all of them are teenagers and are at the point they are making their own decisions. Before Covid, most of our people were very faithful. We had to shut down for several months because of government restrictions and when we reopened some didn't come back. We have seen a few visitors here and there. Pray for us because we have had a Charismatic church move right over top of our church. We have been renting a storefront building for several years, but our landlord has allowed another church to rent the second floor.

Thank you for your love and support. We need your prayers for our people here.
