Please pray for Jon Canavan. He first visited NYC as part of our summer Jewish-Evangelism program, and now returns as a missionary. He rented a storefront in the Bronx and has begun having services. We are committed to going soul-winning once a week to encourage him and his family. I admire his faith in starting during winter and in the midst of COVID-19.
