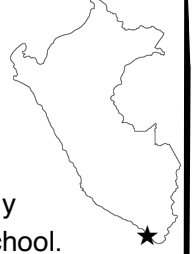

Please pray for us as we continue to minister to these families. We are continuing the Saturday morning Bible club in Viñani, but have moved it to be held in the park where we had VBS. It is a blessing to see many of the new children coming now. Bethany Homan, the missionary we are working with, is planning to begin a weekly Bible club in the other location, starting this week. It will be on the

property that has been recently purchased for the Christian school.

It is exciting to see how God is working and providing for that ministry as well. Please pray for Bethany, for wisdom in the many decisions concerning the school, and for provision for the necessary expenses.

## Visitors

Despite Omicron (we recently had an outbreak at the church and are still limited to 60% building capacity), God has blessed with a number of visitors in these months. Several have chosen to place their faith in Christ. We have had families visit from Colombia and Venezuela. The humanitarian crisis they face in these places is very real. Please pray for us as we seek to be a spiritual help to these needy people.
