On Tuesday evening Feb. 1, my wife and I stepped out of the house for a few minutes to purchase some medical supplies for Hannah, and on the way to Wal-Greens we were in a vehicle accident. Praise God there were no serious injuries. By God's grace and through the sacrificial giving of 24 churches & individuals we were able to purchase a vehicle this past week. We are so humbled and grateful for those who gave so generously towards this!

There are a couple of very heavy burdens on our hearts, that we must share with you at this time. Our daughter Hannah, continues to decline in health. We have seen numbers of doctors, specialists, and hospitals and still have no clear diagnosis/treatment for her. She is currently fighting an Ecoli infection, and still hasn't eaten food in several months. We are all exhausted physically & emotionally as we watch her suffer through tear filled eyes. Also, in the midst of this storm we are now faced with finding a new home in the next 70 days. God is always good and He is always right and He knows best! Would you continue to pray?
