Last week, we traveled to Manchester with the Downeys for a missionary retreat. We had a great time meeting other missionaries working in the UK and reuniting with some we had met before. We stayed busy with various activities during the week and had a wonderful time of fellowship. In addition to our nightly meetings, the ladies had a Bible study and went shopping while the men enjoyed breakfasts and Bible study together and time at the Ninja gym and go-cart tracks. In addition to her co-planning tasks, Dana will be speaking at both of these meetings, so we ask that you please pray God would give her the words to say.
