A month ago, two of the four people he has been meeting with received Christ as their Saviour! We were all ecstatic! I have been able to accompany him for the last two meetings, and I have watched four new Christians diligently listen to the Word of God. They have had questions and it was clear they had studied the material ahead of time. It was amazing! They are in a city with no church. They have, until now, never had an opportunity to hear the Word of God, and they are hungry for the truth. We as long-time Christians take for granted the blessings that God has given us. I wish we would remain that hungry for the things of God!

Yesterday, the Lord gave me the opportunity to share the Gospel with someone for over an hour. Reaching people in Spain is far different than what I was accustomed to in the US. Because of the Spanish culture, I am not offered the opportunity to witness near as often as I would like, and that is why when that opportunity presents itself, I take full advantage of it!

It was incredible to watch this person soak in all the information. Although they did not receive salvation in that moment, I know that they have heard that Jesus is the Way, the Truth, and the Life, and that no one will enter Heaven without Him. I pray that God will give me more opportunities to reach out again as well as to others.

I have much more that I could say, but to close I must say again thank you for your constant prayers and support! My family and I are truly blessed to have a small part in your lives, and we are honored that you have allowed us to represent you in taking the Gospel to such a needy place.
