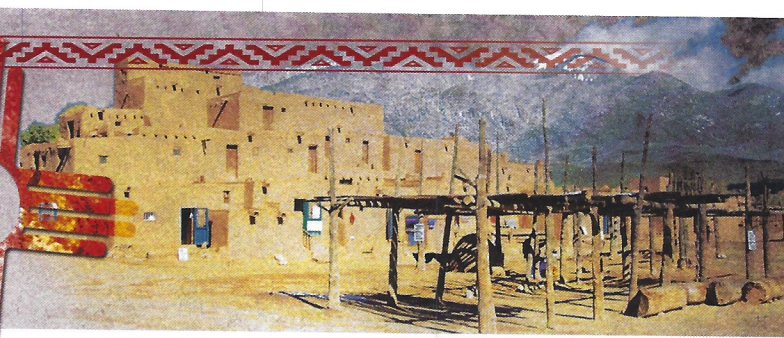

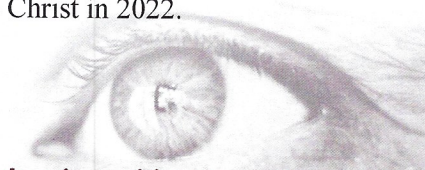
Dear Prayer Warriors,

January was full but much of our other work was neglected as we worked around the clock caring for Dorothy and preparing her house to sell which had become something you see on television shows! Dorothy is now moved to Washington to be with her daughters and is settling in a little better now. Pray for us as we continue to try and help the rest of the family as it is a mess! Caleb and Joy both had their second bout with covid at the end of January; however, we did not struggle with it nearly as bad this time.

Our building situation is quickly coming to a head. We have two buildings that we are looking at that are for rent and would be temporary solutions as they are pretty small without much room to grow. We also are looking into a property that "fell" into our laps that is for sell. It is a one acre fenced in lot with a 3,400 sq ft house and a 4,000 sq ft metal building on it. The house is move in ready and the building needs some work to finish it. The property has some amazing possibilities and we are trying to be careful not to get too excited but are prayerfully seeking the Lord to provide a way for us to obtain this property. This Friday, Caleb is meeting with a contractor to see how much it would cost to finish and update the church part. All our people are planning on coming by to see it. The owners are asking \$479,000 which seems reasonable. We are still not even close to this amount but are trusting the Lord to provide the funds and open doors that no man can open if this would be His will. We are praying that through this whole situation that God would show Himself so strong on Mountain View's behalf that everyone would have to look and say, "only God". We are trusting Him for direction and peace. We are reminded of Isaiah 55:8, "For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, saith the LORD." We must take time to thank all of you who have already given to our building project. We are so thankful for your generosity, love, and prayers for us and for the people of New Mexico.
