For the past three months, he and his mom have been back in the States, where he could receive the needed treatment, and the rest of their family remained in South Africa to continue running ministries here. Praise the Lord, Thanny's last scans came back clean, and he was able to complete his final round of chemo! However, this marks just the beginning of a new chapter. There is still much healing, doctor's appointments, and scans throughout the next several months, which will require him to remain close to Duke Children's Hospital. The rest of the family plans to fly to the US in July, so they can spend one month of much needed time together. Please pray for strength and comfort for the Bergeys as they process through the last months and look towards the future. We rest in knowing that God is good. Even when the waves around us seem so high, He is still in control. He calms the storm.
