We will be mostly in the western United States and will, unfortunately, not be able to be with all our supporting churches during this short furlough. The new building is almost ready for occupancy, and we are planning on having our 3rd anniversary and inauguration service in our new location on June 12th, 2022! I will be sure to send a video of the progress for everyone to see.

We have exciting news about the second work in Manacor. We have started the process of securing a building in that city. We have found a locale that we are very happy with. It needs a bit of work, but the price and the location are wonderful! Markie is discussing the terms with the owner, and we pray that we will be able to start the second work on the island there in the coming months.

We had the opportunity to travel to the peninsula of Spain. We were able to see many friends we haven't seen since our survey trips and report to a supporting church in Rota. We also had the opportunity to visit with the Loveday family and their church in Madrid. They mean so much to us as they played a huge role in helping us receive our legal residency in Spain.

Jessica was able to make a short trip to the US this month to see her younger brother and sister graduate high school, and we are very grateful to her mother for allowing that to be possible. That meant that the kids and I had a very busy week without her, and we give thanks to the Lord that she made it back to us safely!

Although we do not want to leave this wonderful place to which God has called us, we are looking forward to our furlough. We are grateful for all the Lord has accomplished here in the past two and a half years. We are eagerly anticipating all He will do upon our return to Spain in September!
