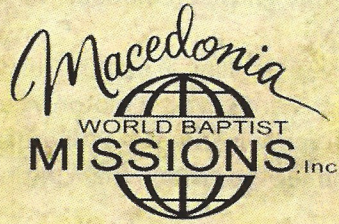

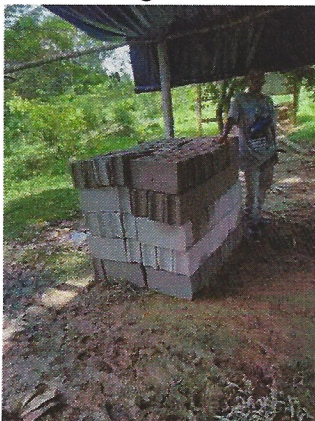

The first of April, our daughter Lydia Graduated from Anchor Baptist Bible College in Pisgah Forest, North Carolina. We are very proud of the work that she has done during these three years there. She believes that the Lord wants her to be involved in missions, and at this time she is working there in their mission warehouse and food bank.

We are paying a motorcycle taxi to carry him there and back. The last Sunday of May saw a good attendance of 30 or more in our church there in Kaukira. We praise the Lord for those members that are remaining faithful in attendance and for the visitors that continue to come.

Upriver, Bro. Nichin was able to make quite a few block before the early rains raised the river level. As you can see in the picture, the new church brush arbor floor is mostly mud right now, showing that the June rains began in May. The construction on the church in Auka has had to wait because of the rain. They are looking to pour the cement floor as soon as there is a break in the weather.

Bro. Andy is still having fun preaching and teaching at the new work in Puerto Lempira. The folks there are literally doing as the biblical church of Berea. When he preaches something that they have not heard or contrary to what they believe or have been taught, they are looking in scripture and accepting what the scriptures are teaching them.

We praise the Lord for offerings that have been given for the young man Leben, to help with his hip surgery. So far there has been \$2,600.00 come in for that. Once we are able to save up \$2,400.00 more, we will be able to send him in to get the surgery done.

Our plans for the month of June at this point, after the wedding and the birth of the grandbaby, (whichever comes first) are that we have meetings in Georgia, Tennessee, and the Carolinas, along with two weeks of Missionary training and a Youth Conference. And then most of the month of July I will be back in Honduras.

Thank you for your prayers as we have been working and traveling in these last two months. We would appreciate your prayers in the coming days as we travel and minister here in the US. For Jacob and Kayla in the birth of Samuel, as well as Levi and Mary Lou beginning their life together.
