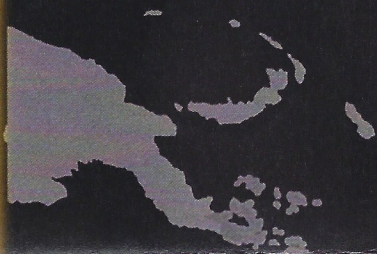

Dear Friends,

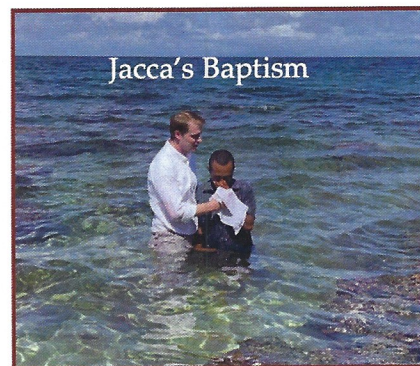
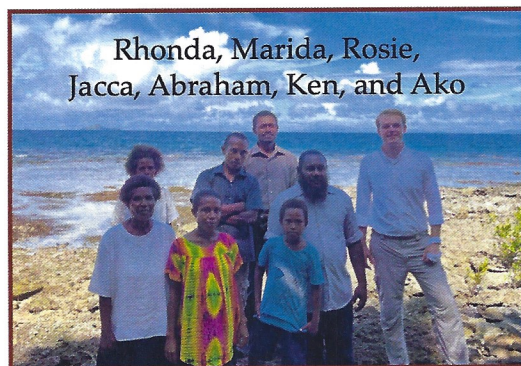
