To our Beloved Brethren in Christ,

**Our Report:** We wrote last month and informed you of our intentions to leave for OR on June 27th. We were delayed and plan to leave now on July 5th. The first contract on our house did not go through and delayed us by a couple of weeks. However, what seems to be a delay is God's timing, and we rejoice in the Lord's guidance. We do feel there was some hindrance and opposition that the Lord overcame for us in all of this. We ended up making several small repairs and fulfilling several small requests and then underwent a major repair with the sewer line and septic tank for our house. Praise the Lord for how God enabled us, and how the Lord sent in extra support to cover the extra expense. God graciously used Calvary Baptist Tabernacle in Knoxville, TN to supply the extra that was needed for the septic repair and then God allowed us to keep some of what they gave to apply toward moving expenses. We have had several churches send in extra support to help with the cost of getting our family moved out to Oregon—Thank you so very much.

We have been sowing the Gospel seed as we have been in TN and have enjoyed VBS at our Home church, and spending some extra time with 3 brothers who attend there. God has called two of them to preach, and their brother is an avid student of the Word and we are praying for God's direction in his life. Please pray for Mark L.; by the time you receive this letter, we will have spoken with our Catholic friend and former co-worker one more time concerning the Lord Jesus Christ and the Gospel, if God permits. Pray for Holy Ghost conviction to settle heavy upon his heart and remain with him until he is converted. Pray for Sean and Sue H. who bought our house and are moving from CA to TN. Pray for James and Zack who are building houses adjacent to our former house and property in TN, and need the Lord in their hearts and homes.

We have also just finished our second commentary, *Truths to Live By in 1 Timothy*; if you are interested in getting one or several—please let us know. Proceeds go to print the Gospel and more books.

Once we leave Harriman, TN we head to Buffalo, WY for the Northwest Orientation School for MWBM. From here, we will make our way on over to Redmond, OR. Our first priority will be to get our family settled in and bring some stability for our children. We will be pursuing housing and ask for your continued and fervent prayers for this, especially in this current market. We have been praying for God to open up the right place at the right price.

- for authority when teaching and preaching Jesus Christ before the people.
- for God's Word to make inroads into the hearts of Oregonians.

- for adequate and affordable housing in the vicinity of Redmond, OR soon after arrival.

**Our Rejoicing:** We rejoice in how the Lord knows what we have need of before we even ask Him. Referring to the heathen, our Lord said, "Be not ye therefore like unto them: for your Father knoweth what things ye have need of, before ye ask him." (Matt. 6:8). The plumbing company which we were required to use to repair the issue quoted us the job, and after it was repaired, we were only charged a little under half the original quote. God sent a man named Benjamin and then had a man move all of the way from Seattle, WA to TN and they came out to fix our issue. God was at work in all of this and saved us money, and got the Gospel to a "North-Westerner" in our backyard over a septic tank! We rejoice in just how much God loves and cares for the souls of the lost throughout the world. Please pray for these plumbers and their salvation.
