Your prayers and financial support make it possible for us to stay on the field and do what God has called us to do.

These past few months have brought excitement and joy as well as a little heartbreak. We are thankful to have seen some new folks attending services at the church as well as fruit of spiritual growth showing in the lives of some individuals we have been discipling. We praise the Lord for these encouraging things, and they are a much-welcomed breath of fresh air. Please pray that these visitors will continue to come and that we will see the lost ones among them come to Christ in salvation. Unfortunately, we have had some of our dear, faithful people to relocate over the past couple of months. The sad reality of the community that we are serving in is that most people move there to seek employment, and a lot of times when another opportunity arises, they will move on. This has mostly been the case with 3 out of the 4 families that moved away recently. Please help us pray that God will send in laborers to fill the void that has been left in our church.

Over the spring and summer so far God has opened many doors for getting the gospel into our town. One of which was for us to participate in the local Independence Day parade in Dickinson. God really helped us, and we were able to get almost 4,000 gospel packets into the hands and homes of Dickinson. We are praying that God will bless these efforts and that we will see fruit as a result.

We are still praying for the Lord's help with the purchase of our church building. Our lease is up this month, and we are going to try to renew it so we don't have to relocate. We are in an excellent location, and I truly believe the Lord has us in this building. Help us pray that God would supply the \$275,000 need. Having a paid off building would be a huge burden lifted from our congregation. If you would like to give towards this need, you can send funds to MWBM with building fund in the memo line.

As far as the family goes, God has really been good to us. Even though our support is still below the 30% mark, God has gone above and beyond to supply our every need. Sister Deanna has begun teaching a Sunday school class again and is really enjoying it. She is going over the books of the Bible. Dakota informed me on the way home from a Tuesday night Discipleship class in June that he had called on the Lord to save him! We praise the Lord for saving his soul. He instantly wanted to start calling family and friends to let them know what God had done for him. Please pray for him as he begins his walk with the Lord.

On July 25-28, we will be taking part in a youth camp in Watertown, SD. We are excited to be taking a group of young people to this and are looking forward to seeing what God has in store for the week. Pray that God will move, that sinners will be saved, and the lives of young people will be forever changed.
