# **Dear Pastor and Praying Friends,**

#### 1 Corinthians 3:9 "For we are labourers together with God...."

We are so thankful for the support, both prayerfully and financially, from each of you over the past two and a half years. As we begin the final month of this ministry of deputation, I find myself reflecting on how good our God is and how the love of God has been manifested through His people. What a blessing it is that we can have a part, no matter the size, of His ministry! And we are beyond grateful to call each of you friend and fellow laborer.

### What's Happened:

During the month of June, we had the opportunity to present the ministry in 10 new churches, across 7 states (GA, SC, NC, OH, MS, FL and TN). June 20-23, we attended the Macedonia World Baptist Missions orientation. During this week we able to glean from some great men who taught on some much-needed topics that we face, or will face, as church planting missionaries. June 27, I had the privilege to visit and speak to a teen group during their VBS. This group of young people have been supporting our family for a full year now, and it was great to be able to see them again.

#### What's Next:

Now that we are in our final month of deputation, it is time to get things ready to go. We have taken a few days and gotten our storage building ready to be put in the truck, and April is slowly packing what we don't need right now. We purposely left our schedule a little more open than normal and will be able to attend our home church a few times before leaving. The boys and I will also be going to youth camp with our church July 7-9. This will be their first time attending camp, and they are excited.

Being only a few weeks away from moving is an exciting time for our family, but it has also shown to be an emotional time. The past few weeks have seemed to be a reality check for Cash and Carter. They have begun showing emotions when we talk about leaving, but I am glad that we have had assurance of the resilience of children. They are excited about moving to Utah, but they also realize that comes with a price.

Our home church, Glade Baptist Church, will be having a "SEND OFF" service for us on July 31 at 6 pm. Then, the following morning, we will begin our journey to St. George, UT. We would ask that you would help us pray for a safe and uneventful trip across the country.
