Dear Co-Labourers,

Greetings from the Northwest USA. We trust you are rejoicing in God's blessings. Psalms 67:3, "Let the people praise thee, O God; let all the people praise thee." The last Psalms in the book of Psalms start out with "Praise ye the Lord."

The last two months have gone by so fast. We left Georgia on June 8th. We were in Hilltop Baptist Church in Riceville, Tennessee on June the 9th. Then on Thursday we left for Buffalo, Wyoming to get ready for the Northwest Orientation. We spent the next few weeks getting ready for classes, doing the grocery shopping, and getting desserts baked.

We had a great week of orientation. We had 18 families there with classes in the day for the adults, and VBS for 60 teens and younger children. At night we had preaching services. We had a choir each night and a children's choir on Wednesday night. We had Dr. Joel Logan, pastor of Tabernacle Baptist Church, Greenville, SC preaching to us each night. We had 25 folks from our home church, Old Suwanee Baptist Church, come and take charge of the VBS. They were such a blessing. VBS also included taking those young folks bowling. We had so many youngsters that we had to divide that into two groups, one on Tuesday morning and the second on Wednesday morning. We also had Rev. and Mrs. Allen Blanton and Rev. and Mrs. Danny Moore take charge of the kitchen duties to feed such a large group.

All those coming arrived safely. We had families coming from California, Montana, North Dakota, South Dakota, Washington, Utah, Idaho, Missouri, and those on deputation from the location of their last meeting. God blessed so that all the food and supplies were paid for, and we were able to give \$500.00 to the church planting families to help with fuel, food and motels while traveling. We want to thank all of you who helped these families with their traveling expenses. It was such a blessing.

Of course, when God is blessing, there is opposition. We have had some truck problems. Ray Godfrey was involved in a traffic accident in Idaho after the Orientation (they are okay, but their car was totaled), Caleb Ballew had truck problems in South Dakota on the way back to Virginia, and Scott Allen is still in Montana with truck engine problems.

After Orientation, I went to Grace Baptist Church in Billings, Montana to help for two weeks. I was also able to be with Pastor Pruitt in Red Lodge, Montana at Beartooth Mountain Baptist Church.

Please keep us in your prayers as we travel. We love you and appreciate all you do for the Lord. Thank you again for your prayers and financial support. God bless you.
