Ministry

The last few months have been so blessed and busy it's hard to even know where to start. The church continues to grow, and see God's blessings. We have yet again set a new record for attendance, had several families to join the church, and watched the average attendance increase. We have also seen the highest attendance yet at our East Belgium Bible Study. Pray that the nearly 1,000 invitations we gave in that city will help us to see further fruit in that needy part of the country. Please pray also for the family that hosts this Bible study, as the wife who has had lung cancer in the past, recently has had the cancer return.

In June we had two major events for our church that helped us to take major steps forward in our growth. The first was a conference we held with Pastor Shakour of Tabernacle Baptist Church in Wilson, NC, and a missions team from their church. This was the first conference we have hosted, and was really a help to our church. The missions team was also a great help in door knocking and street preaching while they were with us. For the conference we had more than ninety people to attend the meeting; from more than twenty nationalities, and at least six different churches. The second was our church's five year anniversary celebration. This was the day our attendance reached over eighty people. We had many of the people from the church give testimony of how it has impacted their lives, and played a slideshow of the church's history. That video is available on our YouTube if anyone wants to see the slideshow.

July and August are traditionally slow months, and while that was somewhat true of July, August saw a surge in church attendance. These months also saw several babies born into the church, one of which was Lory's niece. During this time we had our annual barbecue for Belgian national day, and our Thanksgiving testimonial service. Be sure to look for pictures of many of these events on the second page.

The biggest news we have had in this time, is that our church building was sold to a new owner, who wants to use it for herself. Because of this we have been given until June of 2023 to find a new building. We are now very much in the process of purchasing a building. At this point we have raised around \$60,000 toward the down payment. We have two buildings we are looking at that are around \$700,000 each. We are praying for wisdom about which one God has for us. We hope to send an update letter soon to explain more about which building God is leading us toward, and to show you pictures of the building.
