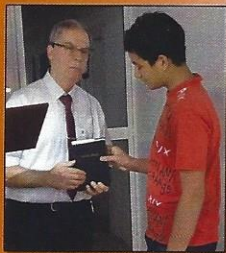

We thank the Lord once again for you being there for us and for the privilege to share with you once again what the Lord has been doing to get the gospel to the people of Valledupar, Cesar, Colombia and with our family. The weather has been unusually rainy, with hot steamy days and some a with a few degrees lesser heat. In the heat of the day, there are few people out and when it rains, even fewer. With lots of mosquitos, there is a lot of dengue here.

Things On The Political Side

Colombia now has the first leftist president in history. Please pray for the changes that are taking place. We really do not know how religious freedoms will be affected. There are efforts to carry out the peace accords that were agreed on in this area back in 2017. There is more crime and violence since the uncertainty of things is affecting the day-to-day life here.

Struggles Here

We were hindered a good bit by having the car in the shop. We waited 50 days for the repair. We have never had to wait that long for a repair. The Ford dealership said it was because of a radiator hose that was on backorder. As a result, we were using taxis to travel anywhere we needed to go.

Things With The Work Here

We have seen that many of the large churches here are building back bigger. We do not know how the small size of the building where we are affects regular attendance. We are still praying about and trusting the Lord to guide us to another place or a lot for the Church. We were able to see a few saved evangelizing in one of the barrios that we were in. Also, a boy from Venezuela was saved in one of the regular Church services. We still see several Venezuelans from time to time.

Brother Simeon has been taking over for a few days since we have not been there. Please continue to pray for him and his family. Please pray for his work situation that he will be able to do more as he prepares for the ministry. When we fly back into Bogota at the beginning of September, I hope to be able to be able to follow up on some medical exams.

Plans For Coming Months

We plan to have a missionary with us in October. He is serving in a city on the outskirts of Bogota called Chia. He is married to a young lady who trained with us during the years we were in Bogota. We are looking forward to having them with us for a few days. In addition, we plan to have a group with us to have evangelistic meetings in the coming months.

Prayer For My Family and Myself

Some months ago, I wrote about the need for a minor surgery. It started out with my ankles and flat feet. Upon doing further studies and an MRI, I need to see a neurosurgeon for disks in my back. I have been seeing a chiropractor, which helps, but a neurologist has referred me to see a neurosurgeon. Please pray that the Lord guide us in working that out. I really need to get that done in Bogota, Lord willing.

We have enjoyed seeing my mom again even though for a very brief time. Once again, we cannot be thankful enough, first to the Lord and to you for your faithful prayers and giving.
