We hope this letter finds you all well and serving the Lord. It has been a busy time for us. Thank you so much for praying for the youth conference. We saw God work in a great way. We had over 300 young people from different cities and towns and states. Many teens heard the Gospel for the first time.

We are excited to let you all know that the Lord has opened the doors to start the Iglesia Bautista Monte Sion (Mount Zion Baptist Church) in Termas del Río Hondo, Santiago del Estero. Termas has over 60 thousand people, and the city has a great need for the gospel. Churches here are teaching a works based salvation.

The Lord has provided an excellent store front that's close to the main highway. Lord willing, we will have our first service the first week of September. We have been going out soul-winning house to house 4 to 5 times a week in the area. We also have an announcement in the main radio station and also a car that goes around the neighborhoods with the announcements for the church. We have several people that said they would come to the inauguration service. We would like to ask that every person that reads our prayer letter to please take some time and pray for the Mount Zion Baptist Church.

Starting a church takes a lot of prayer and work and also a lot of expenses. We will be spending around 3,000 dollars to start the church.
