Not only did his ministry lead to souls being saved, but he had a great impact on the lives of young preachers, pastors and missionaries who are serving around the world.

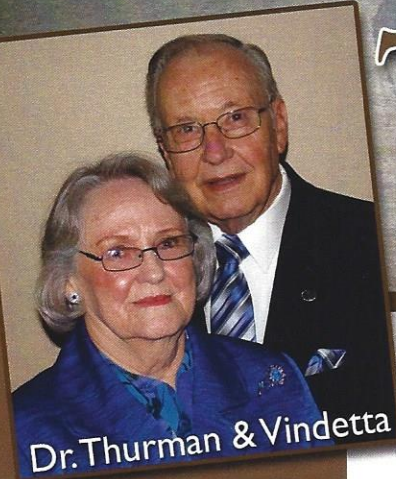
