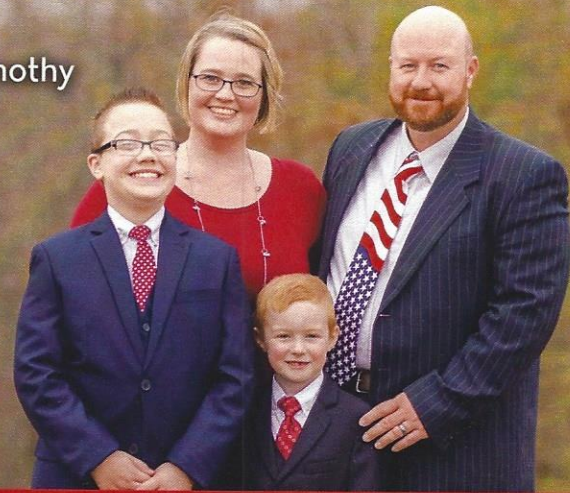

Both boys have been cleared by their doctors apart from watching Timothy as he continues to have post-concussion migraines. Thankfully these are becoming less and less. My back still gives me fits, but overall, I am doing very well. Dawn lost feeling in her right leg but to our amazement has been able to walk due to therapy. We recently found out her right leg still has no reflex, and the doctors are very concerned. She also has major memory problems that she is going to a traumatic brain injury center for. On the outside you will look at us and say wow they look fine after such a horrific accident and we are, we just have a few lingering things to navigate through. All I can say is God is so good and we feel so unworthy to still be alive and doing what He has called us to do with more determination than ever.

We were able to get a new vehicle and keep pressing towards getting to Wallace, Idaho. We have seen God do mighty works in our physical bodies and in our spiritual lives through this scary time. We have an even bigger burden for our soon to be community and cannot thank God enough for His blessings. **Psalm 68:19 Blessed be the Lord, who daily loadeth us with benefits, even the God of our salvation.
