Winter is here once again. We have already had a blizzard and have about 6 inches of snow on the ground with temperatures dipping below zero at night. However, we still are about the Lord's work.

A few weeks ago we had a couple saved at church. A young couple with a baby. They aren't married, and therefore, we won't allow them to join the church; but as in many cases like this before, after they get saved the Lord starts dealing with them about living in sin, and they usually get married. Several folks are now coming out for Thursday night visitation. Winter makes it a little more challenging, but we do what we can. December 16th, we are planning one of the biggest events I think we have had at the church. We are going to have a Christmas musical and a Christmas dinner afterwards. A pastor friend and his daughter from Alabama are coming up to sing and preach between songs. My daughter and her husband will be here singing also. Then we have several in the church doing some songs. My wife and I will also attempt a song. My wife can sing, but I was not blessed with a singing voice, but I can play the guitar while my wife sings. We are inviting the community in hopes the Lord will touch their hearts and they will accept Christ as their Savior. Please pray with us about this event.

We have been live streaming all of our services ever since the pandemic. We have been using basic equipment to do it. An old camcorder that is probably 15 years old with an old sound system and put together with many cables and wires. It looks like it has finally failed. My intention was to stream the services until everyone started coming back to church and then discontinue it. However, this has kind of evolved into an important ministry of the church. Some of our people have to travel out of town for several weeks at a time to work and like to watch the services. We have even gained a few people who watched our services online and then visited the church and have stuck with us. I also had plans to start a 10 minute Bible study several times a month in hopes of reaching people in the community who may not attend church but have questions about God and the Bible. I want to keep this ministry going so we are going to have to get new equipment now. It looks like it is going to cost about \$2500 to get set up to have good quality video and audio to live stream. Please help us pray about this expense as well.

We are grateful to all of you who sacrificially give so we can reach the people here with the Gospel. We thank those also who pray for us and the ministry in North Dakota. May the Lord bless each of you.
