> Though we are incredibly sad to leave this amazing and needy country and the people here, and we do not always understand His will and His timing, I have found comfort in Esther, and we know that God had us in Palma de Mallorca "for such a time as this." With the help and power of the Lord, we have had the incredible privilege to assist in the great Iglesia Bautista de la Comunidad, and we could not be more proud at all the Lord has done. During our time here, we have been able to see people saved. We have seen thousands receive the gospel, and we trust that the Lord will use that to continue to speak to hearts. The Lord gave me the privilege of teaching the Bible through Sunday School and our Bible institute as well as preaching in services. I also had the opportunity to train the church's next piano players. We watched God perform an amazing miracle through all of you in the purchase and remodel of our church

building. Our church now owns its own building and does not owe a cent. Praise the Lord!
