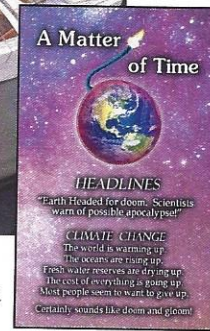

My father-in-law, Don Swaim, once wrote,

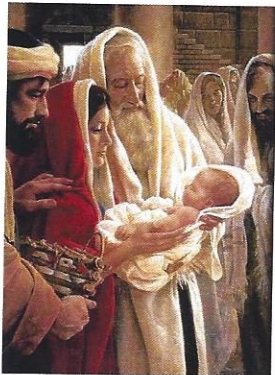
