We had meetings with very high temperatures, but we thank God that we have been able to purchase two large fans. In these months, there are no jobs in Termas de Ríos Hondo, so many people go to other cities to the south of us to work. Then they return in March. Some brothers in our church had to leave the area to go to work this summer. Pray for God to help us, and pray that we can continue forward despite these difficulties. We know that we are not alone. God is with us.

In the month of December, we had a big conference in the church that my father started. We had services with over 1,000 people in attendance, and many accepted Christ and surrendered to serve the Lord full-time.
