Throughout the following weeks, though, we were constantly engaged in the tedious procedures of reintegrating ourselves into our community. Our hearts were blessed to see some of our people still faithful to God in their personal spiritual walk with the Lord. However, one of our men has "fallen away" (Lk. 8:13), but God has already given us opportunities to visit him at his home, and he's already attended two of our mid-week meetings and one Sunday evening service. Please be praying with us for José Aparecido de Oliveira. José is saved but needs encouragement to return to church and serve the Lord as he once did.







Another family who often attends our services, the eldest son of a family in our church, is suffering the consequences of bad choices in life. The father and his three children were forced to move back in with his parents because the mother completely abandoned her husband and children. The young father's situation is even more complicated as one of the three children, a six-year-old girl is not his child but his wife's daughter from a previous relationship.
