Please be in Prayer

First, pray for Josiah. He has had strep throat 5 times since June. He will be having his tonsils and adenoids removed the first week of February so we hope this will be the end of it.

Second, is that you would continue to help pray about a replacement vehicle for our Toyota Sienna. We have some money saved up for the purchase but want to make sure we hold off until we find what we need. We are praying about an All-Wheel Drive van.

Lastly, pray that the LORD would open a door for us to be able to move to the west side of the state. Housing costs are higher where we are praying about moving and there are some obstacles that need to be addressed before we could make the move. We have been praying about this for quite some time and would ask that you pray along with us.
