Camilo Encina, our missionary to Ecuador, came to the states in January to visit some of his supporting churches. On January 14, while he was still here, his wife, Mariela, began to have

some difficulties with her pregancy. She had to be hospitalized, and Camilo immediately cancelled his meetings and traveled back to Ecuador. After three days, in the hospital, Mariela had a placental abruption and had to undergo emergency surgery. Two days later, their daughter, Hefzibá, passed away due to her premature birth. Please join us in praying that our Heavenly Father, who is the God of all comfort, would comfort Camilo and Mariela's hearts as they grieve the loss of their daughter.
