I want to thank each of you for your prayers and support. Last year, I just hit 20 years with Macedonia World Baptist Missions. It is hard to believe how faithful God has been.

Deborah and the boys are doing well. We have enjoyed our time on furlough, and we were able to go to TX, NC, GA, TN, SC, NY, MD, and KY. This furlough we were able to visit the Alamo and the Ark exhibit and had some family time. Joseph is now 15, and this next term will probably be the last term we will have all together. Pray that God will lead our family in the right decisions for Joe's future.

Between Thanksgiving and Christmas we were invited to go back to Texas for a missions conference. While we were driving there, our van was struck by lightning about an hour before we got to Dallas. We were driving 75 mph in the rain, and the van was struck by lightning, and it fried some electrical parts. We are now at almost the end of January, and we are still waiting on parts. Pray for us because I have had to postpone our flights so I can get the van and sell it to pay off the vehicle loan before we fly back toward the end of February. Pray that we can get the vehicle fixed soon so I can fly to Texas to drive the van back to VA.

We are looking forward to getting back to the field and trying a few new things. We have preached on the radio for years and will continue to preach on the radio. I will try to get into some area schools as well as printing some basic discipleship materials. We have many people that are illiterate in our area and over half of our church is. Pray that we can go forward in this area. I am also looking toward a few new local areas to try to start a second work or a preaching point. Our village will take a long time because it is steeped in native religion mixed with Christianity which is a mess. Pray that God would give me direction.

Pray for us as we are waiting on Jeremiah's birth certificate to come in the mail; we had to send it off to renew his passport. Pray that we can get some last minute paperwork and other things done in the US before we go back to Ghana. Pray that we can get all our paperwork together for Ghana. Pray that we can get refocused on Ghana as the pace of life is very different.

This furlough was shorter than normal, and we didn't get to see many of our supporters. This is the first time I haven't been to as many as usual. We will visit many of you we didn't get to next time as you will be the priority. Pray that God will continue to guide in a plain path and that I will follow His leadership. Pray that God would call some Ghanaians into the ministry.
