Hello again from Valledupar, Cesar, Colombia. We thank the Lord for this and every opportunity to share what is happening with us and in ministering to the needs here in Colombia. The weather here has been partly windy, hot and dry, and not very predictable.

Day to Day Changes

The government here is changing. One area being greatly affected is health care. Its effects are something we have experienced up close and firsthand. The insurance companies are basically under fire to bring about reforms in private healthcare. Crime is at record proportions. Taxi drivers are protesting the lack of law and order.

Needing A Second Surgery

We returned to Valledupar before school started back in the middle of January. Bro. Simeon helped for several weeks while we were away. Before we left Bogotá, the surgeon had ordered some follow-up tests. First, a lab test for thyroglobulin showed the need for further tests. The doctor ordered an MRI and a map ultrasound. Some small tumors showed up in the ultrasound. After biopsies, the doctor scheduled another surgery to clean those out on the 14th. of March. Please be in much prayer that the Lord be merciful and gracious to respond.

Prayers For Help & Things Going On

Thank the Lord, after praying and asking for help, the Lord answered by a group in Mexico that has responded. A young man, (Joel Martinez) is now with us and will be helping us until June when he graduates from seminary. Also, as we head back to Bogotá, we have planned for the first week of March, to have an evangelist (Edgar Reyna) and his wife (Cesia) be here in Valledupar for a couple of weeks. Please help us pray that the Lord bring fruit from their time here.

We have been blessed by getting to see some of the things here up and running again. We have been able to evangelize and see professions of faith, have youth meetings, ladies' and men's services, and hope to see more done. A man named Elbert has been visiting, also, another person has begun to tithe, and a little girl was saved after the service on Sunday.

Other Prayer Requests

Please help us pray for Bro. Julio Cesar. His cancer has come back and is now in his bones. He has been dehydrated and is in the hospital as I write this. We still are calling on the Lord for a miracle. Bro. Jose has been stable with his prostate cancer. Seeing Julio Cesar's worsening condition has been very difficult for him.

We try to get as much as possible done traveling back and forth to Bogotá. Lord willing, we will be getting Timothy's U.S. passport renewed. Hannah is back in classes at PCC and is studying very hard. All of us appreciate your prayers and kindness in reaching out to her.

As always, we thank you for giving yourselves to the Lord in being faithful to intercede and give that the work here would continue and that the Lord be glorified.
