During her healing time, on February 6, I had my permanent back spinal stimulator implant. It is helping my pain but will take some time to get the right level of stimulation figured out. Then on February 20, she had her pacemaker implanted. She is being monitored to make sure that the pacemaker takes care of all the heart issues. We are both on the mend for now.
