Once again we are thankful to come to you with an update of how the ministry has been over the last several months. First, I want to say to God be the glory great things He hath done. It is so wonderful to be able to serve such a great God.

First, I would like to give you an update of Harvest Baptist Church and its ministries. During the last part of 2022 and into the first part of 2023, there seemed to be a great amount of sickness going through the church. It took several weeks to get what seemed like the whole church well again. Since then we have seen decent numbers in attendance, as well as a steady stream of first time visitors. We have seen several people saved as a result of visiting our church or our church family winning people to Jesus in the community. We have several evangelistic emphasized days coming up this spring and early summer. We ask that you pray that we might see fruit for the Lord's Harvest from those. A few weeks ago some men in our church we're able to go and help Pastor Eli Morgan canvas doors for a day in Raton, New Mexico. We are thankful to be able to invest our time, finances and prayers into this new church plant in Northern New Mexico.

Second, we were able to be a part once again of the Southwest Baptist Fellowship of Evangelism meeting held during the month of January. This fellowship meeting was born in my heart a couple of years ago. The Lord has used it to rally around 30 different pastors and churches in the state. This meeting was held at High Plains Baptist Church in Clovis, New Mexico. It's hosted by a different church in our state every 4 months. The purpose of this Fellowship was so that we as pastors and churches might gather together for the hope of evangelizing our state. This is done through the fellowship and support for church plants as well as existing churches in the Southwest. During the year of 2022, this group of pastors were able to raise \$20,000 to help six different church plants in this region of the country. Already this year we have seen \$7,500 come in for two different church plants, and we hope to see much more over the years to come.

Third, we are also excited about what God's doing across the border down in Casas Grande's, Chihuahua, Mexico. We were able to finally close on the piece of property that we began the process of purchasing last year. This property will be used as a place to build a church building as well as a pastor's parsonage. The Lord allowed several churches back East to give towards the building of these buildings that will be built. We thank Heritage Baptist Church of Watkinsville, Georgia, Lighthouse Baptist Church of Jackson, Georgia, and Mile Creek Baptist Church of Six Mile, South Carolina, as well as a number of individuals who have generously given towards this project. We need to raise approximately \$45,000 for these two structures and so far \$32,000 has come in. To God be the glory! Finally, the family is doing well. The boys and girls all have different projects going on at the farm. Some are raising chickens, some are raising pigs. Others are getting ready for the greenhouse season to start seeds for vegetables. Courtney stays busy with church projects on the weekend and during the week homeschooling the kids. Continue to pray for the Rogers family and His Harvest Ministries.
